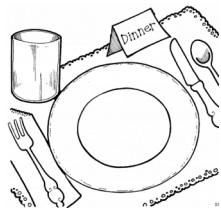


**Oops...July 12**


