
God approves all these qualities and is honored when His children ask, according to His will and without wavering/doubting.

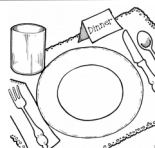


The **Property Ministry Team** is in need of people willing to use the push mower, tractor or weed trimmer on our lawn. It is a massive job and extra helpers are needed!
