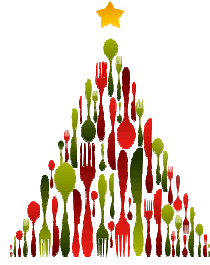
All one dollar bills in the offering plate today will be given to some needy person or family.

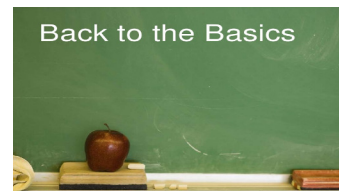
