- 1. They foresaw His coming to earth.
 - a. The fact of His coming
 - i. More than three hundred predictions in the Old Testament of Jesus' first coming
 - ii. Isaiah is commonly referred to as the "gospel prophet" or "Messianic prophet."
 - iii. The Jews of Jesus' day looked for the Christ to come. (John 1:19-25; 5:39; 4:25)
 - b. The time of His coming (Daniel 9:24 ff)
 - c. The place of His birth (Micah 5:2)
 - d. The events of His life
 - i. Crucifixion (Psalm 22: Isaiah 53)
 - ii. Luke 24:25-27, 44-47; Isaiah 53:7, 8 and Acts 8:32-35
- 2. They foresaw the Christian Dispensation.
 - a. The coronation of the Messiah (Daniel 7:13, 14; Acts 1:9)
 - b. The day of Pentecost (Joel 2:28-32; Acts 2:16-17; Zechariah 13:1-6)
 - c. The making of a new covenant (Jeremiah 31:31-34; Hebrews 8:8-12)
 - d. The conversion of the Gentiles (Zechariah 8:22-23; Romans 9:22-26; Zechariah 6;12, 15; Ephesians 2:11-13)
 - e. The New Testament system of justification (Habakkuk 2:4; Galatians 3:11; Romans 1:16, 17; Hebrews 10:38)
- 3. They even foresaw Eternity.
 - a. Joel prophesied the Day of the Lord. (Joel 2:31; 2 Peter 3:10)
 - b. Daniel prophesied the resurrection. (Daniel 12:2, 3)
 - c. Isaiah closed his book prophesying of eternity. (Isaiah 66:22-24; 2 Peter 3:13; Mark 9:43-48)
