

Back to School Prayers

*** Prayers for Peace (Isaiah 26:3; Philippians 4:6-7; Romans 5:1)**

*** Prayers for Protection (2 Thessalonians 3:3; Psalm 46:1; John 17:15; Psalm 91)**

I pray You will guard our minds from harmful instruction, and grant us discernment to recognize truth.
