Parents worry that their children are not being fed twice a day at school during summer. It was reported in the Daily Sun that 22.5% of children in Sumter County go to bed hungry. The Soup Kitchen needs several specific items for the snack packs they put together for Wildwood schools. During June and July, there will be boxes at the doors where you can make a donation with cash or check. Checks should be made out to the Church and designated “Snack Packs”. The Mission Team will buy the needed for the snack packs; the Soup Kitchen will put the snack packs together and distribute them. \$10 will provide snack pack items for 6 children, \$40.00 will provide for 25 children, 60 will provide for 37 children, \$100.00 will provide for 62 children.
