### **Alarm System Update**

There are several administrative procedures that need to be addressed before using the system. We are planning to begin the end of January. We will definitely let everyone know when it is being used.

### **Session Minutes**

Jeremy Wilks, representative of Sierra Communications, gave instructions for use of the newly installed alarm system and demonstrated entry through a personal code.

Newly elected Elders for 2020 were introduced by Reverend Mickey for examination. Sherie Alldredge, Doug Richards, Peggy Elliott, and Karen Brown each presented their "faith journey" and/or favorite scripture. The motion was made and unanimously approved to recommend the slate of officers for installation.

<u>Stewardship and Finance:</u> Financial Report was unanimously approved.

<u>Building and Grounds:</u> The motion was made and approved to replace the East door with a levered bronze colored knob along with bronze colored knobs on the front door and other wooden entrance doors.

#### Mission and Outreach:

\$400.00 has been received from the Resources Ministry of Palo Duro Presbytery to purchase shelving for FPC endorsed Nolan County Food Pantry.

FPC congregation has donated \$660 to assist the NOROC Children in Romania Program.
Angel Tree donations will be delivered to the Children's Advocacy Center.

The Christmas Joy Offering will be collected during the Christmas Eve Service.

#### **Worship Committee:**

Kirk Stroman will present his annual "Reflections Piano Program" on Sunday, December 17 at 6:00 p.m. in the Sanctuary.

A motion to approve Communion dates and Elder Classes for 2018 was unanimously approved.

### **Special Business:**

Rev. Marie Mickey forwarded an email on November 30, 2017 for purchase of a Synthetic Stucco Monument Sign (5'x10'x 15") to replace the decaying sign on the East front lawn by Creative Graphic Solutions. The motion was unanimously approved.

A new Christmas tree was purchased for the Sanctuary. A majority agreed to discard the old Christmas tree.

Reverend Mickey reported that she attended the Buffalo Gap Camp Meeting ("Buffalo Gap".) Buffalo Gap currently has funds in the amount of \$29,000. An application for additional funds is being submitted. They are currently seeking ideas for fund raising events. Buffalo Gap is requesting sponsors for children to attend camp.

Reverend Mickey announced that she will be taking vacation from December 26, 2017 through January 3, 2018. On December 31, 2017, there will be a service of lessons song appropriate to Epiphany led by Cathy Reed and other volunteers. Stephanie Wiele is providing special music
