### **Session Minutes**

<u>Clerk's Report</u>: The Clerk read correspondence from Palo Duro Presbytery. The Common Life Ministry Team sent a missional grant check for \$2,500 to the church for use in the Blessing Box ministry. The Ministry Team stated that "together we are grateful for your church's mission to lift high the cross of Jesus." The grant application was prepared by Hilary Brennan.

**Stewardship and Finance:** Financial Report was unanimously approved. Session members approve changing the Proposed 2022 Budget to include a 5% cost of living adjustment for all staff members.

**<u>Building and Grounds:</u>** The Building and Ground Committee reported that no bids had been received for proposed work in the garden area.

Mission and Outreach: Paula Huckabee of the Mission/Outreach Committee will present a "Minute for Mission" on the Christmas Joy Offering at the Worship Service on December 19<sup>th</sup>. Session members discussed purchasing a sign to promote the Candlelight Communion Service on December 24<sup>th</sup>. Jeannette Bryant will work on this project.

**Personnel:** Session approved the 2022 Holiday Schedule.

**Worship Committee:** Jim Gesin of the Worship Committee reported all classes of elders will coordinate to serve Communion at the Dec. 24<sup>th</sup> service. He also reported that his committee was working on having a hand chime choir on a regular basis. He will order music books for their use.

Moderator's Report: The Moderator reported that Beau Stearns had donated a tripod to be used in videoing Worship Services. The Moderator also reported that several people had expressed an interest in joining the church. She will continue discussions with them.

<u>New Business:</u> Session members voted to hold a Congregational Meeting following Worship Services on Dec. 26<sup>th</sup>. Purpose of the meeting will be to elect the Elder Class of 2024.
