

LADIES GUILD

The Ladies Aid Society of Calvary was officially organized on October 12th, 1934, with fourteen charter members: Mrs. O. Cadore, Mrs. G. Clark, Mrs. H. Harwood, Mrs. F. Gerber, Mrs. E. Gerhardt, Mrs. H. Miller, Mrs. A. Mueller, Mrs. C. Norder, Mrs. J. Norder, Mrs. G. Rosenberger, and Mrs. J. Seggebruch. In 1971 the organization became known as Calvary Ladies Guild.

The purpose of the organization is to promote Christian education and knowledge, and to stimulate Christian fellowship and render Christian service. Over the years, countless meals have been served by the members of Ladies Guild, including wedding receptions, funeral dinners, congregational dinners, Lenten meals, and meals for Vacation Bible School. The May meeting is the annual Mother-Daughter Banquet for congregation members and guests. Income is used to support local food pantries, Concordia Seminary Food Pantries, Prairieview, and Harbor House, among others.

All women who are communicant members of Calvary are invited to attend meetings usually held the second Wednesday of the month, beginning at 6:30 p.m. Current officers are Catherine Williams, President; Donna Koester, Vice-President; Nancy Kollman, Treasurer; Shirley Smith, Secretary.
