St. Giles Church to Host Rocktoberfest!

St. Giles Episcopal Church has been a fixture at 3025 Walters Avenue in Northbrook for over 60 years. To celebrate that anniversary and the “end of summer, beginning of fall,” they will host a family-friendly outdoor celebration for the public on Sunday, September 30th from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Three local bands will perform, and food, beverages, and games will be available.

Senior lay leader Mike Piskel stated, “Rocktoberfest is an opportunity to share in some outdoor autumn fun, food, and good local music with our neighbors in Northbrook and beyond. The bands that are playing will feature a fantastic classic blues band out of Northbrook and Glenview, **King Robinson and the Housewreckers**; a hardworking and talented classic rock cover band, **Skydeck**, that features senior students from Glenbrook North; and an acoustic guitar duet, **County D**, composed of two Glenbrook North teachers who play well known pop covers. There really is something for everyone to enjoy.”

Along with the music St. Giles will have traditional Oktoberfest treats including brats, beef and veggie burgers, hotdogs, drinks, and other offerings. Games, including garden jenga, cornhole, a bouncy house, and more, will be available for kids and adults.

Come and enjoy a fun filled Sunday afternoon at the St. Giles grounds. Admission is \$10 for adults, \$5 for students, and free for children 5 and under. Food and beverages may be purchased on site. All proceeds from the event will go to furthering the mission of St. Giles: “We feed people- body, mind, and spirit. Come as you are.” Tickets may be purchased at the door, or at the church office.
