

Ash Wednesday Service

In the Western Church, Ash Wednesday is the first day of Lent, the 40-day period before Easter. On Ash Wednesday ashes are blessed and imposed with the sign of the cross on the foreheads or on the back of the hands of Christians. The ashes are traditionally made from burning the palm branches blessed the previous year on Palm Sunday.



This night we acknowledge our sin. We also acknowledge that too often we have failed to proclaim the good news in word and deed.
