History of Juneteenth:

On **January 1, 1863** President Abraham Lincoln issued the Emancipation Proclamation and it went into effect.

On **June 19, 1865**, over two years after the proclamation went into effect, General Gordon Granger and his troops arrived to Galveson, Texas proclaiming freedom from slavery in Texas.



The **following year, 1866** freedmen in Texas organized the first of what became the annual celebration of "Jubilee Day" (Day of Jubilee) on June 19.



In **1872**, Black leaders in Texas raised \$1,000 for the purchase of 10 acres of land to celebrate Juneteenth, today known as Houston's Emancipation Park.



By the **1890s**, Jubilee Day had become known as Juneteenth.



In **1979**, Democratic State Representative Al Edwards of Houston, Texas, successfully sponsored legislation to make Juneteenth a paid Texas state holiday.



By **2019**, 47 states and the District of Columbia recognized Juneteenth, although only one state (Texas) has adopted the holiday as a paid holiday for state employees.

On **June 15th, 2021**, the Senate passed a bill to make Juneteenth a federal holiday.
