

Outdoor Worship at JKPC-- Things to Know and Do **Revised 3/9/2021**

The Worship Committee is excited to be welcoming our JKPC family back to church in person, outdoors! We are doing our best to keep the services as safe and healthy as possible, including physical distancing, requiring masks throughout the service, use of disinfectants as appropriate, and minimizing touching of shared surfaces. Here are some details you should be aware of:

Before the Service

1. **Sign up with Signup Genius** to reserve your spot, or call the JKPC office, by Friday at noon before the service. **Please sign up even if you are in leadership** (pastor, music, sound, ushers, etc.) so we can keep an accurate count of people in the courtyard. If possible, volunteer to usher or clean up after the service-- no experience necessary.
2. **Print the bulletin and song lyrics**, which will be sent by email on Friday.
3. If you have a **prayer request**, email it to Randy by Saturday.
4. **Do not come to church if you feel sick or have a fever.**

Bring to the Service

1. A **chair** (chairs will be available if necessary).
2. A **mask** (masks will be provided if you forget)
3. A **printed bulletin and song lyrics** (a few extra will be available if you forget).
4. A Bible and/or offering if desired.

When You Arrive

1. **Please arrive on time.** If you have not signed up, you might need to wait in the parking lot to see if there is space left in the courtyard for safe seating. If you are late, your spot might be given away to someone who is waiting.
2. Enter through the **main gate only**, by the main parking lot and breezeway.
3. **COVID-19 symptoms** will be posted on a sign when you enter. Please read these. If you think you might be ill, please go home. An usher will take your temperature and ask you about any possible symptoms.

4. Enter the courtyard, and find a place to **set up your chair**. Rows for chairs will be marked with empty (red) chairs, 6 feet apart, alongside of Rooms A - D. Set up your chair, preferably next to the empty chair, if you are first in that row; or 6 feet away from someone already in that row. Couples and families stay together to maximize space for all. Ushers will be available with a measuring stick to assist if needed.

5. **A table will be set up** near the office, with an usher stationed behind it, to hand you a bulletin, mask, hearing aid, Children's packet, Communion cup, or to collect offering as needed. Hand sanitizer will also be available there. If you don't need any of these items, just stay seated.

During the Service

1. Keep your **mask on** throughout the service.
2. **Please refrain from moving around** as much as possible, except for standing and sitting.
3. The **bathrooms** in the sanctuary building and near the office will be open, and only one person will be allowed inside at a time in each bathrooms.
4. **Children** will stay with parents throughout the service.
5. **Enjoy the service!**

After the Service

1. Please try to keep a **6 foot distance** from others as you exit.
2. There will be **trash cans** available in the breezeway for used bulletins and Communion cups.
3. Feel free to **chat with friends**, but stay aware of the 6-foot distance guideline, and **please remain masked**.
4. Children are **not** allowed on playgrounds.
5. If you have **volunteered to help clean up**, see Sue Wilburn or Sue King-Irwin for instructions.
6. If you find, within 2 weeks of attending the Outdoor Worship service, that you **test positive for COVID-19**, please call the church office at 925-828-1846 or Sue Wilburn at 925-785-3318. We will need to begin contact tracing.
