ACTS CHAPTER 3

"I WILL GIVE YOU WHAT I HAVE"

Acts 3:1-11

- LOOK AT US
 - You have to be ready
 - You have to get their attention
- HE HAD EXPECTAIONS
 - They know what they want
 - They think they know what you will give
 - They could be disappointed
- HE GOT MORE THAN HE EXPECTED
 - If they accept our spiritual gifts it will be more than they expected
 - If all they get from us is physical assitance, then we have been stingy

IT LEAD TO MORE MINISTRY

Acts 2:12-26

• WITTNESS:

- IN THE TEMPLE
 - Why are you surprised?
 - It is God who did this so that Jesus could be glorified
 - Faith has made this happen

BEFORE THE COUNCIL

- Authorities got angry
- They got to tell the authorities, they were ready
- They refused to stop

BELIEVERS PRAY FOR COURAGE

Acts 4:23-31

- Peter and John give their report
- The believers lifted their voice in praiseful prayer
- They again went out with boldness

HERE IS THE STICKY PART

- The Lame man
 - Lame from birth
 - Rejoicing at first then what?
 - His only skill: begging

WHAT DOES HE NEED NOW?

- Physical Shelter
 - Food, Clothes, Housing, Hygiene etc.
- Spiritual Teaching
 - Jesus, God, Holy Spirit, Holy living etc.
- Life Guidance
 - Job skills, Handling Money, Commerce skills,
 Managing a Household, Marital skills etc.

THE EARLY CHURCH HAD A SYSTEM

Acts 2: 42-47; 4:32-36

- THEY FORMED A COMMUNITY
- Christian Community: <u>FAMILY GROUPS</u>
 <u>AND INDIVIDUALS THAT WORSHIP</u>,
 <u>STUDY, FELLOWHIP, WORK, SHARE</u>,
 <u>AND CARE FOR EACH OTHER FOR THE</u>
 <u>EXPRESS PURPOSE OF GLORIFIYING</u>
 <u>GOD AND SPEADING THE GOSPEL</u>

WHAT DID THIS COMMUNITY DO?

- They devoted themselves to the Apostles teaching and fellowship
- The met together collectively and in each others homes
- They shared what they had
- They worshiped every day
- They took care of each other.

- 12. You are failing to adapt to the changes in society.
