SAINT ARNOLD'S HOME BREWED BEER COMPETITION

Rules

Categories

- **Hops: IPA's, etc.**
- **Easy Drinking: Ale's,**
- **Dark and Malty: Stouts, porters, etc.**
- **Specialty: Anything else**

Specify on your entry form (theoretically, it should be obvious to the judge – but if they've been warming up too long, who knows).

- Each individual can submit as many entries as they wish. Cost for single entry is \$15 with the next 2+ entries will be \$5 each. There is no limit to how many entries you wish to make.
- Because of the nature of this contest, no judges will be allowed to enter their beers. Beers must be brewed in a home setting. No commercial or brewed on-site beers allowed – particularly on-site.
- The beer must have been brewed by the person entering it. Team beers are acceptable, but the entrant must have been an active participant in the brewing process.
- There are four categories with the Specialty category pretty open to anything you would like entry.
- Entries must be delivered to judging room day of event – Saturday, October 27th no later than 10:30am.
- 24 ounces of beer per entry (if you would like provide more, we won't complain).
- Each bottle must have the printed bottle label that is provided when you submit your entry. The label must be affixed with a rubber band. No other labels or markings are acceptable. **Remember your number – no one else will.**
- We prefer 12 ounce bottles with unmarked caps. Printed caps should be blacked out with marker.

- Please see Style Guidelines found on the website to best determine which category to classify your beer.

Process:

- Entries will only be accepted between 9AM – 10:30AM on Saturday, October 27th in the Judging Room.
- Judging will begin at **11:30A** sharp.
- Late entries will NOT be judged – they will be consumed though.
- The entries will be sorted into the 4 categories. Beers will be group based on designation of the entry and judged in the order as listed above.
- The judges will use slightly modified BJCP Beer Scoresheet and fill out score sheets for each entry. Each judging category listed below:
 - Aroma 10
 - Appearance 5
 - Flavor /Taste 20
 - Mouth feel 5
 - Overall Impression 10
- Any entry can receive up to 50 points – highest score wins. If there is a tie – then the beer will be re-sampled by new judges.
- A panel of highly ranked (legends in their own minds) judges will determine the 1st and 2nd place beers by category.

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
