Scripture: Isaiah 55:10-11 For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and do not return there until they have watered the earth, making it bring forth and sprout, giving seed to the sower and bread to the eater, so shall my words be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and succeed in the thing for which I sent it.

Thought: I read this passage on New Year 's Day and thought that it was truly meant for me. I thought that it went right with the sermon that on Sunday December 30 that encouraged us to think about making the resolution to end all resolutions "to be about God's business." Prayer: Father God we ask that you will spark in us a deep desire in our hearts to read your word this year. Transform us through the renewing of our minds as we read your word this year and use us to transform your world.
