Don't forget Children Sunday School every Sunday at 10:00 am in the Children's Building.

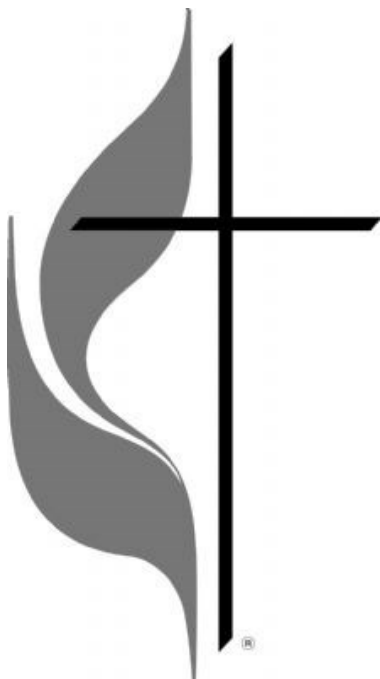
