

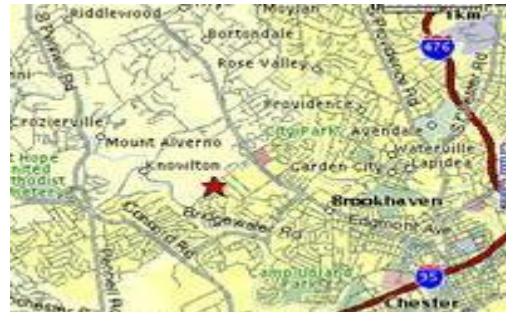
Our History

Christ United Methodist Church has its roots deep in beginnings of the Methodist movement in Pennsylvania, beginning in 1818 when meetings were held at the Kelly home in Chester. From these early meetings on the "Circuit" came the Chester Methodist Church and Madison Street ME Church in 1849. As Chester grew there was need for additional congregations and in 1871 the **South Chester M.E. Church** was founded. Later known as **South Chester United Methodist Church**, the congregation moved in 1965 to the present location at the edge of Brookhaven Borough and Middletown Twp., and became **Christ United Methodist Church**. In 1983 Madison Street UMC merged with Christ Church, and in 1994, upon the closing of the Providence Avenue Church, and then Crozerville UMC and Parkside UMC, Christ Church again embraced many new members. Today, Christ Church's congregation reflects the heritage of the earlier Chester congregations while providing spiritual guidance and fellowship to Brookhaven and the surrounding communities.

Please join us for worship at 10:00 am each Sunday. Nursery is provided during the worship service. Coffee and snacks are provided for everyone in our Fellowship Hall after Worship. **On the 1st Sunday is communion, and at 1 pm, join us for the Shining Light Worship service geared toward those with Intellectual and Developmental disabilities.
