

COVID-19 CODE OF CONDUCT FOR USERS OF THE CHURCH

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. **COVID-19 is extremely contagious** and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, federal, state, and local governments and federal and state health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, prohibited the congregation of groups of people.

To protect our employees, volunteers, and other individuals who utilize our facilities, all employees and volunteers and users are required to agree to this Code of Conduct.

Please read and initial next to each of the following statements indicating your understanding and agreement. Please direct any questions to [Stephen Ream, Trustee].

_____ I will not enter church facilities if I have symptoms of COVID-19. Such symptoms include, but are not limited to chills, shortness of breath, dry cough, sore throat, or a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher. If I develop such symptoms, I must be symptom-free for 72 hours before returning to Church facilities.

_____ I will limit my exposure by complying with all state, county, and local stay-at-home orders. I will follow any recommendations from the CDC that limits my risk for exposure and by remaining 6 feet from all other people, sitting or standing.

_____ For those 2 years or older and medically able, I will always wear a mask while on church property.

_____ I will wash my hands using CDC recommended handwashing procedures throughout the day.

_____ I will cooperate with any attempts to prevent exposure on Church facilities by the taking attendee temperature, if requested.

_____ I will NOT enter the Kitchen, except Kitchen Staff and Kitchen Renter, as we are not using it for our own purposes needing it to be sanitized for renters.

_____ I will sanitize the area used after each meeting which includes all of the common use areas such as hallway and restrooms and door handles.

_____ I will immediately notify [Stephen Ream, Trustee] if I test positive for COVID-19, am a presumed positive, or if I develop any of the symptoms of COVID-19 listed above.

_____ I will immediately notify [Stephen Ream, Trustee] if I become aware that I was exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or is a presumed positive.

I have read, understand, and agree to comply with the provisions listed herein. I acknowledge that failure to act in accordance with the provisions listed herein, or with any other policy or procedure outlined by the Church may result in my termination of employment or my loss of volunteer privileges.
