

I heard a disturbing statistic recently from the Southern Baptist Convention: baptisms are at a 74 year low. The baptism of 12-17 year old children in 2019 has dropped 38% as compared to baptisms of the same age group in 2000. Something is wrong with this picture. Has our burden for the lost waned that much over the years? Is our vision for evangelism big enough to reach outside the walls of our churches?

God, in His sovereignty, has placed each Christian in their particular town and church to reach the lost of that community. You are not alone in what God has called you to do and God has provided everything you need to accomplish this task. He has given the church the Holy Spirit to be empowered for the work. He has given the Word of God to instruct and enable believers to reach out to the lost.
