

Happy New Year from the Baptist Student Ministry!

We are excited to announce the Paris Junior College Baptist Student Ministry will be taking a mission team to Beach Reach 2020 on South Padre Island during Spring Break, March 7-14, 2020. What is Beach Reach? "Beach Reach South Padre began in 1980 with 20 students who had a vision to reach their peers during Spring Break. It has progressively developed into the extensive ministry that it is today. Now during Spring Break, hundreds of Christian college students join together to verbally share the gospel of Jesus with those they encounter as they seek to meet their physical needs for food and transportation."



We will be doing several different activities on this mission project. Primarily, we will be sharing the gospel through and during our Free Breakfast, Sunscreen Distribution, Midnight Breakfast, as well as Beach and Street Witnessing during the day and evening. In years past, we were able to share the gospel with over 10,000 students and saw so many people come to know Jesus as their Savior, in just one week!

As you know, The Baptist Student Ministry is not a separate organization, but rather a part of the greater ministry and mission of the Red River Valley Baptist Association. # Spiritual Fitness for a New Year

Have you made any New Year's resolutions? So many try to make and keep resolutions for the New Year and typically fail to follow through. Some join a gym, others go on a diet, yet others commit to stopping a bad habit or begin a positive something in their lives. We hear a lot about getting physically fit, but not much about getting spiritually fit. Psalms 119:1-16 give us a good foundation for staying spiritually fit while waiting for Christ's coming or our home going. Following are some thoughts to consider.

Begin by understanding the blessings of God on your life and give thanks to the Father for His goodness. Keep walking in His ways; keeping His commandments and seeking Him with all your heart. Then comply with the authority of God's Word by obeying it diligently and giving Him praise for it. Seek and sense God's presence with you in all situations and circumstances. He is always near and promised to never leave vou.

The Psalmist sums it up with these thoughts - seek God on a regular basis, not sporadically. Store His truth in your heart - His Word in our heart leaves no room for trash in the mind. Share Him with others unashamedly. Celebrate what He is doing in and through your life. Spend time meditating on His principles to bring you closer to Him. Finally, satisfy yourself in Him and His goodness.

On a different note, Jo Ann and I have visited 24 of the 47 churches in RRVBA. At each one we have been blessed richly by the pastor and congregation. To all pastors and churches of RRVBA, I pray God brings you a blessed and wonderful New Year.
