- b. <u>AD 54-56</u> Acts 19 Paul spent 3 Years teaching and preaching in Ephesus.
  - i. Filling of the Holy Spirit

  - iii. Repentance and Turning from works of Satan to God (Burning of Books)
  - iv. Church begin to impact society. (Riot ensued because of loss of business to Silversmiths)
- c. <u>AD 57</u> Acts 20 Paul meets with the Elders of the Ephesian church in Miletus on his way to Jerusalem to give them a final farewell and instructions.

  - 1. No ministry lasts forever.
- viii. Responsibility to God for what we tell others or don't tell others (26-28)
  - 1. Innocent of the Blood of all men
  - 2. Not shunned to declare to you the whole counsel of God
    - a. Ezelkiel 33 Again the word of the Lord came to me, saying, 2 "Son of man, speak to the children of your people, and say to them: 'When I bring the sword upon a land, and the people of the land take a man from their territory and make him their watchman, 3 when he sees the sword coming upon the land, if he blows the trumpet and warns the people, 4 then whoever hears the sound of the trumpet and does not take warning, if the sword comes and takes him away, his blood shall be on his own head. 5 He heard the sound of the trumpet, but did not take warning; his blood shall be upon himself. But he who takes warning will [a]save his life. 6 But if the watchman sees the sword coming and does not blow the trumpet, and the people are not warned, and the sword comes and takes any person from among them, he is

> > taken away in his iniquity; but his blood I will require at the watchman's hand.' 7 "So you, son of man: I have made you a watchman for the house of Israel; therefore you shall hear a word from My mouth and warn them for Me. 8 When I say to the wicked, 'O wicked man, you shall surely die!' and you do not speak to warn the wicked from his way, that wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood I will require at your hand. 9 Nevertheless if you warn the wicked to turn from his way, and he does not turn from his way, he shall die in his iniquity; but you have [b]delivered your soul.

- d. <u>AD 60-62</u> Letter of Ephesians written from prison in Rome. (1<sup>st</sup> Imprisonment, would be released around AD 62) This is where the Book of Acts ends, with Paul in prison in Rome, under House Arrest.
