- ii. Silversmith who made silver shrined of the goddess Diana (Latin)(Artemis-Greek)
 - 1. Annual Festival honoring this goddess held each year in Ephesus, Her Temple in Ephesus was one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World.
- iii. He and those of his trade prospered greatly by making and selling images of the Goddess Diana (Artemis)
