Preamble

Since it pleased Almighty God to call us as servants uniting together for the worship of God and the spread of the gospel of Jesus Christ to sustain and prosper this work for his glory, we establish these bylaws to help us accomplish the task of this local church in a "decent and orderly" manner through the use of effective and efficient means of stewardship of one's time, gifts, talents and resources.

Recognizing that God is not the author of confusion, these ministry bylaws are to provide general guidance on organization, governance and operation based upon biblical principles and practices. A notebook is suggested with descriptions of subcommittees and how their successes were achieved, mistakes made, "standard operating procedures," timelines, etc. as a turn-over file for the next leader of each ministry.

In addition, the secretary shall keep a record of minutes and names of ministry participants and their attendance. This will be submitted to the church office each month. The attendance record will be a useful tool in identifying future leaders of this ministry. After each activity and/or event, lessons learned review should be completed so that the ministry can assess the successfulness and areas of improvement for the future.
