"The Day of Christ" relates wholly to the blessing and reward of the saved at the coming of Jesus Christ. The Day of Christ begins the day the dead in Christ are raised from the dead and those who are alive meet the Lord in the air. This period continues through the Judgement Seat of Christ and the Marriage Supper of the Lamb.

"The Day of the Lord" relates to judgement. The beginning of the time frame so designated is at the beginning of the Tribulation and lasts until the Return of Christ to the earth.
