19:10 Paul wrote 1 Corinthians (A.D. 54) Ephesus

- 1. The activity in the School of Tyrannus. (19:9-10)

- 4. The uproar surrounding the loss of sales of the Artemis figurines. (19:23-41)

20:1 Paul wrote 2 Corinthians (A.D. 56) Macedonia

20:2 Paul wrote Romans (A.D. 57) Corinth

The Third Missionary Journey Continues (20:3 - 21:17)

- After a three month stay in Corinth, they traveled through Macedonia, Asia, Troas)

- The situation with Eutychus (falling asleep)
- The journey continues through many cities (20:13-17)
- Paul's moving speech to the people of Ephesus and their response (20:18-38)
- The journey continues (21:1-14) They eventually stopped at Caesarea)
- The journey to Jerusalem (21:15 -17) **The end of the Third Missionary Journey**

G. The Imprisonments of Paul (21:18-28:31)

- The events prior to his first imprisonment
 - People tried to kill Paul (21:27-31)
 - Paul questioned by a commander (21:37-39)
 - Paul gives his defense (21:40 – 22:22)
 - Paul utilizes his Roman citizenship (22:23-30)
 - Paul gives his testimony (23:1vv)
 - Paul imprisoned in Jerusalem (23:10)
1. In Jerusalem (23:10 - 23:32)
 2. In Caesarea (23:33 - 26:32)
 - a. Paul before Governor Felix (24:1-26)

Note: A change of leadership. Festus is now governor (24:27)

- b. Paul before Festus (25:7)
 - c. Paul before Agrippa (25:23 – 27:1)
3. In Rome (28:17)

28:31 Paul wrote Ephesians, Colossians, Philemon, and Philippians
