

# Numbers, Signs, and Symbols in The Bible

## The Number Two (2)

Two is the number of witness, support, confirmation

*“Whoever is deserving of death shall be put to death on the testimony of **two** or three witnesses; he shall not be put to death on the testimony of one witness.” (Deut. 17:6)*

- There are two great [lights](#) (Gen. 1:16)  
*“Then God made **two great lights**: the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night. He made the stars also.*
- There are two [testaments](#), The Old Testament and The New Testament
- Jesus is the second [person](#) of the Trinity. He is known as the faithful and true witness.
- Jesus used many [sets](#) of two in His teaching
  - There were the two houses; one on the sand the other on the rock
  - There are two masters; God and money, which no man can serve both
  - There are the two gates; one is wide which leads to destruction, one is narrow, which leads to life. Jesus used many twos in His teaching.
- In business meetings motions are [seconded](#) (the idea witness and confirmation)
- There were two [angels](#) at Sodom (Gen. 19:1)  
*“Now the **two angels** came to Sodom in the evening, and Lot was sitting in the gate of Sodom. When Lot saw them, he rose to meet them, and he bowed himself with his face toward the ground.”*
- There were two [cherubim](#) on the arc of the covenant (Ex. 25:22)  
*“And there I will meet with you, and I will speak with you from above the mercy seat, from between the **two cherubim** which are on the ark of the Testimony, about everything which I will give you in commandment to the children of Israel.”*
- The 10 Commandments were on two [stones](#) (Ex. 31:18)  
*“And when He had made an end of speaking with him on Mount Sinai, He gave Moses **two tablets** of the Testimony, tablets of stone, written with the finger of God.*
- There were two [witnesses](#) at Kadesh-Barnea (Num. 14:6)  
*“Joshua the son of Nun and Caleb ... who were among those who had spied out the land, tore their clothes.”*

- The were 2 [spies](#) at Jericho (Jos. 2:1)

*“Joshua the son of Nun sent out two men from Acacia Grove to spy secretly, saying, “Go, view the land, especially Jericho.”*

- Two are better than [one](#) (Eccl. 4:9)

*“Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their labor. For if they fall, one will lift up his companion. But woe to him who is alone when he falls, for he has no one to help him up. Again, if two lie down together, they will keep warm; But how can one be warm alone? Though one may be overpowered by another, two can withstand him. And a threefold cord is not quickly broken.*

The power of two is incredible. Think of the things that are accomplish more easily when you have a helper: Making a bed; Working on a car; Doing chores.

- The [disciples](#) were sent out by two by two (Luke 10:1)

*“After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place where He Himself was about to go.”*

- There were two [angels](#) at the resurrection (Luke 24:4)

*“And it happened, as they were greatly perplexed about this, that behold, **two men** stood by them in shining garments.”*

- There were two angels at the [ascension](#) of Jesus (Acts 1:10)

*“And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, **two men** stood by them in white apparel.”*

- There are two [unchangeable](#) things whereby God cannot lie (Heb. 6:18)

*“By **two immutable** [unchangeable] **things**, in which it is impossible for God to lie, we might have strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold of the hope set before us.”*

- There are the two [witnesses](#) mentioned in the book Revelation (Rev. 11:3)

*“And I will give power to my **two witnesses**, and they will prophesy one thousand two hundred and sixty days, clothed in sackcloth.”*

- Consider all the twos in the human body
  - Hands, feet, arms, legs, eyes, ears, kidneys, lungs

- Jesus is there where two or more are gathered in His name (Matt. 18:20)

*“For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them.”*
