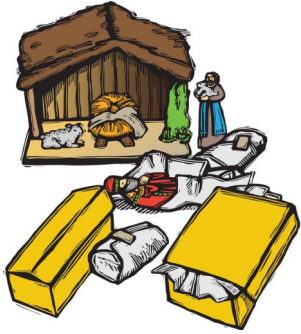

Preparing for Advent

We unpack the family ornaments from the attic, we acquire a tree and string lights. We sing carols at church and in the car. We get out the recipes that came from Grandma and bake sweets we only eat once a year.

All this seasonal magic takes preparation: presents are thoughtfully selected, purchased, and wrapped. The calendar requires careful attention in order to juggle Christmas gatherings and extra commitments. The grocery list is carefully curated to make sure you forget none of the family favorites. If you’re really good, you’ll do all this before the mall and the baking aisle of the grocery store look like the “after” scene from an apocalypse movie.

I’ve been thinking about what it means to prepare. Both Advent and Lent are seasons of preparation in the Christian calendar and faith, but they are different kinds of preparation. In Advent we are preparing to receive something vulnerable—a baby, yes, but also a God who dared to be made flesh. How do we prepare to receive the divine gift of vulnerability and then turn to seeing and advocating for those whom are vulnerable in our world?

What if we were to prepare for more than just the festivity and presents and lights? What if we prepared to welcome the Christ child into our lives and prepared enough room for him to stay after the tree is on the curb and the decorations are back in storage? What if this Advent we opened our hearts and prepared enough room to receive not just the baby sweet and mild in the manger, but the man and ministry that changed the world and has the ability to change our lives?

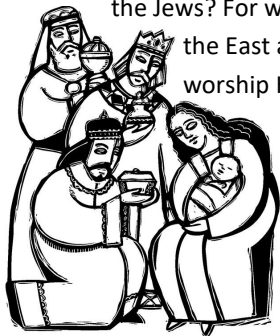


And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn. Luke 2:7

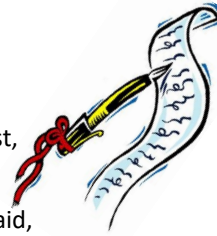
