GRAND VISION

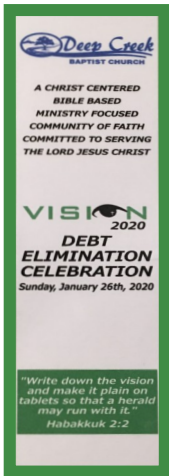

The exciting part is we are on this journey and in search of this Grand Vision together. God is at work among our congregation and I am honored and humbled to be on this journey with each of you.

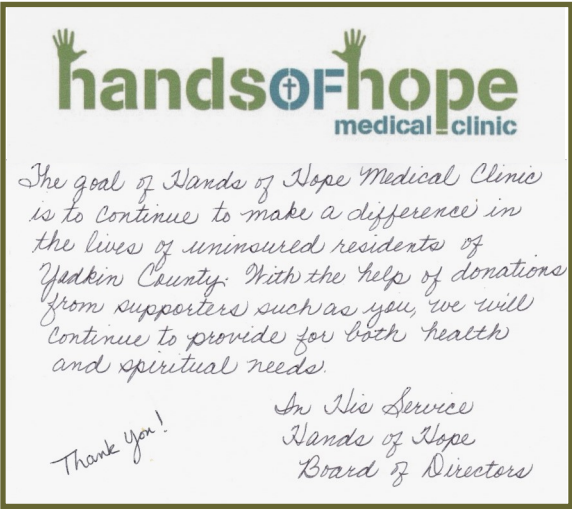
