Deep Creek Baptist Church Long Range Planning Committee Update

On Sunday, August 18, 2013, John Fuller, our architect will present the design changes proposed for the renovations of the educational building and the fellowship hall. From inception, the goal of the Long Range Planning Committee was to keep you, our church body, informed and updated about these renovations. Your presence is requested at this important meeting to talk with the committee and the architect regarding the proposed renovations. The evening will begin with homemade ice cream at 4:00 p.m. We are asking that you make your favorite ice cream and bring it to share with everyone. As soon as the ice cream is served, we will move to the fellowship hall for the presentation.

Following are some of the main changes:

Renovations of bathrooms to meet building standards: This actually requires more space than is currently present so finding an alternative place for part of the restrooms is required.

Renovations of the kitchen: The current kitchen is too small for preparing meals and serving during activities with medium to high numbers of people in attendance. The proposal for the kitchen is to move it closer to the existing back door and enlarge it. This will allow a window for serving food and a separate window for depositing dirty dishes. It will also allow more room for work and preparation in the kitchen.

Renovations of mechanical systems: Due to the age of the existing systems, the mechanical systems for the lower and main floors are being updated.

Waterproofing: Waterproofing the underground, outside walls of the existing facility is proposed.

Some of the issues the property committee will address prior to the actual renovations are: abating asbestos-containing tape on the existing ductwork, and appropriately dealing with any downspouts not currently connected to allow water to be directed away from the building.

As part of the presentation, we will provide pictures of churches that have some of the changes being proposed. We look forward to seeing each of you on Sunday evening, August 18, at 4:00 pm in our church fellowship hall.
