Over 25 years ago Virgie Scott, a very wise and sweet senior lady, informed me that her mother always told her to "remember that this is not living, it is preparing to live." As I stand on the brink and watch another year slip away—I have to ask myself if I spent the last year preparing to live. Did I take time to get to know my Lord better so that when we meet face to face, I will be well acquainted with Him? Are the things I spent my time

doing things I can bring to Him, or will they remain behind in a place that will ultimately cease to exist? Are my treasures piled up here where moth and rust will corrupt and thieves seek to steal? What portion can I identify as having eternal value?

What treasures have I sent on before me to the place where I will ultimately live eternally? Whom have I taken the time to show how they can come with me, or join me, when they are done preparing to live? Have I made another's life better here and for eternity? Which takes precedence for me? One theologian said that no matter how we improve lives here, if we don't prepare those people for eternity, we have wasted our time and resources. Do I believe that?

Do you resent the phrase "so heavenly minded they are no earthly good"? I used to. But I'm beginning to see that the opposite is so often true of my moments, and days and years. Oh, that I may be so focused on the eternal that I'm not bothered by the temporal. Our example Jesus, did much earthly good, but it was because He was so heavenly minded. I like the turn of phrase "Thy will be done, as in heaven, so on the earth." If you study the book of the Apostle John, you will see exactly how heavenly minded the Son was. All He did and taught came from the Father. He did nothing that did not come first from the Father. I wonder if we can be any earthly good if we are not first heavenly minded.

As you look over the brink to 2019, will you plan to spend it preparing to live, knowing that this is not really living? That comes when we're done here.

I remember when my daughter planned her wedding: the dress, the cake, reception menu, candles, flowers, details for the bridal attendants, groomsmen, location, music, and on and on and on. As exciting and challenging as all that was—it was only preparation for the wedding. While doing all that, she and her fiancé spent time intentionally building a relationship because at the end of the wedding, marriage and real life kicked in!

As you prepare and plan for 2019, how and where are you preparing to live? Another piece of profound wisdom came from Jane Helvey, teaching leader at BSF in Winston Salem, North Carolina: "Our greatest joy in this life is knowing that our greatest joy is not in this life." Do you believe that? If so, how will you live that out in 2019!


