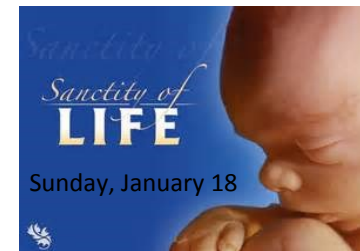

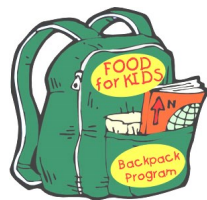

By doing this we are building trust between an un-churched family and our church. This is essential to sharing the word of our Lord Jesus Christ!

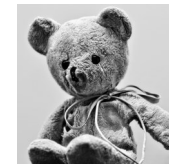

**CHRONICLES FROM NARNIA**

You don't have to be a rocket scientist to see a good idea. So, I asked Doug if it was ok if I borrowed his idea. He was excited about the thought of two different pastors in two different Baptist churches in two different states preaching and teaching the same text. With this in mind, let me share those Top 10 Bible Verses along with the dates for the series I have entitled, "The Chronicles from Narnia:

Please note that the verses listed are rank ordered beginning with the 10<sup>th</sup> most "highlighted" verse and ending with the number one most "highlighted" verse.

Here is what I need for each of you to do before coming to worship on Sunday. First, take time to read each week's verse at least once a day. Record your thoughts, insights, and what you hear the verse saying to you. Remember, all Scripture is living and active and God will speak through His Word if we have eyes to see and ears to hear. For some of you these verses may be life verses that have shaped your relationship with Christ, for others they may be key verses God has used to get you through a tough situation such as an illness, loss of a loved one, financial difficulty, broken relationship, or any other number of life events that test our faith.

Second, call someone within your Sunday School class, community of faith at The Creek, or a trusted Christian friend and simply share what God said to you through the verse. If God has used the verse in a life event that has tested your faith in the past, share it with them. Listen, this might be awkward for the first time or two, but it will become easier as each week goes by. Step out in holy boldness and trust God to help you. Remember, in your own strength this might seem impossible, but with God, all things are POSSIBLE.

Third, prayerfully consider sharing in Sunday worship what God has revealed to you or share a testimony of how God has used the verse to make a difference in your life. Call me if you feel God leading you to share your insights or testimony with our community of faith at The Creek. Powerful things happen when God's people share what He has done in their lives and give Him all the GLORY!


So, Rick, what is YOUR part. First, to fervently pray for the Holy Spirit to move in/thru the Body of Christ at The Creek to open our eyes, our ears, and our hearts to the meaning and truth of His Word. Second, to call three to six different people within the Body of Christ each week and simply share our insights and questions about the verse. Third, to seek God's guidance and wisdom in crafting a short, pithy, meaty homily of 15-20 minutes for each week's verse. This is a risky venture for a preacher, but I believe God is in the business of doing new things. For me the risk is worth the gain. Because I believe with all my heart that there is power in God's Word and that the Holy Spirit uses God's Word to changes lives. This happens when we individually and collectively commit ourselves to earnestly and faithfully read and study His Word.

There is no better time than at the beginning of a New Year than to do a new thing. For some this new thing will rock your boat or rattle your cage. For some this new thing will just be another "church thing." For others this just might be the thing God uses to breath fresh fire on a fading faith. Or still yet, this might be the new thing God uses to bring light into a dark place in someone's life.

How about it. Will you join me in this joint new venture from the pulpit and the pew? Will join me in this new thing and wait in eager expectation of what God will do? Yes, the risk is worth it because God is in the business of making all things if we have eyes to see, ears to hear, and hearts willing to put our faith in Him. SELAH.....Meditate upon these things!
