

Free Indeed

If the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed. John 8:36

Last May I published an article, "Freedom's Price," by a former Soldier in the 160th, a Black Ops unit out of Fort Campbell, Kentucky. I was humbled by the sacrifice of him and his family and realized I did nothing to deserve his service—and the service and sacrifice of so many others. One of his frustrations is the failure of so many of us to walk in the freedoms purchased at such a great cost by so many.

His anonymous introductory statement was "Only two defining forces have ever offered to die for you: Jesus Christ and the American G.I. One died for your soul; the other for your freedom! Freedom is not free; it is bought with the blood of another."

When Jesus forgave the woman taken in adultery He knew what it would cost Him.

In July we celebrate the Declaration of Independence declaring the American colonies no longer subject for the monarch of Britain. This document was written by the founders of our nation and the freedoms were secured by the sacrifice of those who fought for them. Do you know what those freedoms are? Do you live in that freedom?

Many years ago I read a collection of sermons by Peter Marshall, Chaplain of the United States Senate 1946-1947. The one having the most impact on me as a middle-teen and still today was his sermon on the woman taken in adultery. When all was said and done, Jesus looked at the adulteress and said "Neither do I condemn you. Go, and sin no more." Peter Marshall's concluding statement was, "When Jesus forgave the women taken in adultery He knew what it would cost Him."

If you have asked for and accepted Christ's sacrifice freely offered on your behalf, during this remembrance of freedom, praise and thank Him. Celebrate the freedom He purchased for you. But, more than that, walk in the freedom He purchased for you: freedom from death, freedom from the power of sin over you, victory over Satan's attacks against you.

My mind goes to the chorus of the song "Sinner Saved by Grace" by Gloria Gaither:

Now I grow and breathe in freedom with each breath of life I take;

I'm loved and forgiven—Back with the living—

I'm just a sinner saved by grace.
