Mark 10: 32-34 "The Son of Man will be delivered to the chief priests & scribes, & they will condemn Him to death, & will deliver Him to the Gentiles. And they will mock Him & scourge Him, & crucify Him, & three days later He will rise again."

Luke 18: 31-34 "Behold, we are going to Jerusalem, and all things which are written through the prophets about the Son of Man will be accomplished"

Is. 50: 4-7 "The Lord God helps Me, Therefore, I have set My face like flint."

Luke 19: 36-40 "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord; Peace in heaven & glory in the highest!"

Mark 14: 36 "Abba! Father! All things are possible for Thee; remove this cup from Me; yet not what I will, but what Thou wilt."

Luke 22: 44 "And being in **agony** He was praying very fervently; and His sweat became like drops of blood falling down upon the ground."

John 18: 1-8 Jesus therefore, knowing all things that were coming upon Him, <u>went forth</u>, and said to them, "Whom do you seek?" Matt. 26: 51-53

Mark 14: 61 "Are you the Christ, the Son of the Blessed One?" And Jesus said "I am." Matt. 26: 66-68 "He is deserving of death. (Luke 22: 64 Blindfolded Him). They spat in His face & beat Him with their fists; & others slapped Him, and said, "Prophesy to us, You Christ; who is the one who hit You?"

Matt. 27: 26-31 "Crown of thorns on His head, took reed and beat Him on the head."

Luke 23: 33-43 "Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing." God answered that prayer by opening up the way of salvation even to Jesus' murderers (which is all of us).

Matt. 27: 44 "Robbers were casting same insult at Him." Mark 15: 32
