

CONFIDENCE IN CHRIST

Rom. 8: 34 "Christ Jesus is He who died, yes, rather who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who also intercedes for us."

Phil. 1: 6 "For I am **confident** of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus.

Is. 53: 4-6 "He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, and by His scourging we are healed."

I Peter 2: 24 - 25 "He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed." **II Cor. 12: 8 - 10**

Heb. 4: 14 -16 "Let us therefore draw near with **confidence** to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and may find grace to help in time of need."

Eph. 3:11, 12 "In Christ Jesus our Lord we have boldness and confident access through faith in Him."

Heb. 10: 19 -25 "Since therefore, brethren, we have confidence to enter the holy place by the blood of Jesus, ----let us draw near with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith."

II Cor. 3: 4, 5 "And such confidence we have through Christ toward God. Not that we are adequate in ourselves to consider anything as coming from ourselves, but our adequacy is from God."

Phil 3: 1 - 9 "I count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord."

Ps. 27: 1 - 5 "Though a host encamp against me, my heart will not fear; though war arise against me, in spite of all this I shall be confident."

Ps. 71: 5 "For Thou art my hope; O Lord God, Thou art my confidence from my youth."

Ps. 78: 5 - 7 "That they may arise and tell them to their children, that they should put their confidence in God."

Prov. 3: 25 - 26 "Do not be afraid of sudden fear, nor of the onslaught of the wicked when it comes; for the **Lord will be your confidence**, and will keep your foot from being caught."

Prov. 14: 26 - 27 "In the fear of the Lord there is strong confidence, and his children will have refuge. The fear of the Lord is a fountain of life, that one may avoid the snares of death."

II Cor. 1: 12 "For our proud confidence is this, the testimony of our conscience, that in **holiness and godly sincerity**, not in fleshly wisdom but in the grace of God, we have conducted ourselves in the world"

Heb. 10: 35 - 39 "Therefore, do not throw away your confidence."

I John 2: 28 - 29 "And now, little children, abide in Him, so that when He appears, we may have confidence and not shrink away from Him in shame at His coming."

I John 4: 16 -17 "By this, love is perfected with us, that we may have confidence in the day of judgment; because as He is, so also are we in this world."

I John 5: 14 "And this is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us."

I John 3: 18 - 24 "Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence before God; and whatever we ask we receive from Him, because we keep His commandments and do the things that are pleasing in His sight."

Acts 4: 29 - 31 "Lord, grant that Thy bond-servants may speak Thy word with all confidence."

Acts 4: 12 - 13 Now as they observed the confidence of Peter and John, and understood that they were uneducated and untrained men, they were marveling, and began to recognize them as having been with Jesus."
