

GLORIFYING GOD

Ps. 86: 12 "**I will give thanks to Thee**, O Lord my God, with all my heart, and **will glorify Thy name forever.**"

I Cor. 10: 31 "Whatever you do, do all to the glory of God."

I Chron. 16: 29 "Ascribe to the Lord the glory due His name"

Matt. 15: 29 - 31 "Great multitudes came to Him, bringing with them those who were lame, crippled, blind, dumb, and many others, and they laid them down at His feet; and He healed them, so that the multitude marveled as they saw the dumb speaking, the crippled restored, and the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel."

Luke 2: 8 - 20 "And the shepherds went back, glorifying and praising God for all that they had heard and seen, just as had been told them."

Is. 43: 7 "Everyone who is called by My name, and whom I have created for My glory."

Prov. 25: 27 "Nor is it glory to search out one's own glory."

John 8: 54 Jesus answered, "**If I glorify Myself, My glory is nothing; it is My Father who glorifies Me.**"

Is. 42: 6, 8 "I am the Lord, I have called you in righteousness, I will also hold you by the hand and watch over you." "I am the Lord, that is My name; I will not give My glory to another, nor My praise to graven images."

Dan. 5: 22, 23, 18-21, 24-28, 30 "But the God in whose hand are your life-breadth & your ways, **you have not glorified.**"

John 21: 18, 19 Now this He said, signifying **by what kind of death he would glorify God.** And when He had spoken this, He said to him, "**Follow Me!**"

Rom. 8: 15 - 17 "The Spirit Himself bears with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him in order that we may also be glorified with Him."

Luke 5: 16 - 25 "And at once he rose up before them, and took up what he had been lying on, and went home, **glorifying God.**"

Ps. 72: 19 "Blessed be His glorious name forever; and may the whole earth be filled with His glory. Amen, and Amen."

Ps. 66: 1, 2 "Shout joyfully to God, all the earth; Sing the glory of His name; Make His praise glorious."

II Chron. 5: 7, 10, 12-14 "To make themselves heard with one voice to praise & to **glorify the Lord**, and when they lifted up their voice accompanied by trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and when they praised the Lord saying, "**He indeed is good for His lovingkindness is everlasting.**" then the house, the house of the Lord, was filled with a cloud, so that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud, for **the glory of the Lord filled the house of God.**"

Acts 11: 1 - 18 "When Peter came up to Jerusalem, those who were circumcised took issue with him, saying, 'You went to uncircumcised men and ate with them.' "If God therefore gave to them the same gift as He gave to us also after believing in the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I that I could stand in God's way?" and when they heard this, they quieted down, and **glorified God**, saying, "Well then, God has granted to the Gentiles also the repentance that leads to life."

Rom. 15: 5 - 7 "Now may the God who gives perseverance and encouragement grant you to be of the same mind with one another according to Christ Jesus; that with one accord you may with **one voice glorify** the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ."

I Peter 2: 12 "Keep your **behavior** excellent among the Gentiles, so that in the thing in which they slander you as evildoers, they may on account of your good deeds, as they observe them, **glorify God** in the day of visitation."

I Cor. 6: 17 - 20 "For you have been bought with a price; therefore **glorify God in your body.**"

Is. 3: 8 "For Jerusalem has stumbled, and Judah has fallen, because their speech and their actions are against the Lord, to rebel against His glorious presence."

I Peter 4: 10 - 11 "As each one has received a special gift, employ it in **servicing** one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. Whoever speaks, let him speak, as it were, the utterances of God; whoever serves, let him do so as by the strength which God supplies; so that in all things God may be **glorified** through Jesus Christ, to whom belongs glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen."

II Thess. 1: 11, 12 "To this end also we pray for you always that our God may count you worthy of your calling, and fulfill every desire for goodness and the work of faith with power; in order that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ."

Hag. 1: 1 - 10 "Go up to the mountains, bring wood and rebuild the temple, that I may be pleased with it and be glorified," says the Lord. "You look for much, but behold, it comes to little; when you bring it home, I blow it away. Why?" declares the Lord of hosts, "Because of My house which lies desolate, while each of you runs to his own house."

John 17: 1, 4 "These things Jesus spoke; and lifting up His eyes to heaven, He said, "**Father, the hour has come; glorify Thy Son, that the Son may glorify Thee.**" "I glorified Thee on the earth, having accomplished the work which Thou hast given Me to do."

John 15: 7 - 8 "If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it shall be done to you. By this is **My Father glorified**, that you bear **much** fruit, and so prove to be My disciples."

II Cor. 9: 6, 8, 13 "Now this I say, he who sows sparingly shall also reap sparingly; and he who sows bountifully shall also reap bountifully." "And God is able to make all grace abound to you, that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed." "Because of the proof given by this ministry they will **glorify God for your obedience** to your confession of the gospel of Christ, and for the liberality of your contribution to them and to all."

Is. 58: 7 "Divide your bread with the hungry, and bring the homeless poor into the house; when you see the naked, to cover him. Then your light will break out like the dawn, and your recovery will speedily spring forth; and your righteousness will go before you; the glory of the Lord will be your rear guard."

Rev. 14: 6 -13 "And I saw another angel flying in mid-heaven, having an eternal gospel to preach to those who live on the earth, and to every nation and tribe and tongue and people; and he said with a loud voice, 'Fear God, and **give Him glory**, because the hour of His judgment has come, and worship Him who made the heaven and the earth and sea and springs of waters.'" "Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on!" "Yes," says the Spirit, "that they may rest from their labors, for their deeds will follow with them." Rev. 15: 4 "Who will not fear, O Lord, and glorify Thy name? For Thou alone art holy." Rev. 16: 9 "And men were scorched with fierce heat; and they blasphemed the name of God who has the power over these plagues; and they did not repent, so as to give Him glory."

Matt. 5: 16 "**Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify you Father who is in heaven.**"
