

REPENTANCE

II Tim. 2: 24 - 26 "And the Lord's bond-servant must not be quarrelsome, but be kind to all, able to teach, patient when wronged, with gentleness **correcting** those who are in **opposition**, if perhaps God may grant them repentance leading to the knowledge of the truth, and they may come to their senses and escape from the snare of the devil, having been held captive by him to do his will."

Jude 1: 9 "But Michael the archangel, when he disputed with the devil and argued about the body of Moses, did not dare pronounce against him a railing judgment, but said, 'The Lord rebuke you'".

Rom. 2: 4 - 6 "Do you think lightly of the riches of His **kindness** and **forbearance** and **patience**, not knowing that the kindness of God leads you to repentance?"

Ez. 18: 29 - 32 "Repent and turn away from all your transgressions, that iniquity may not become a stumbling block to you."

Num. 23: 19 "God is not a man, that He should lie, Nor a son of man, that He should repent."

Heb. 12: 14 - 17

Matt. 3: 8 "Therefore bring forth fruit in keeping with repentance."

Acts 26: 19, 20 "Consequently, King Agrippa, I did not prove disobedient to the heavenly vision, but kept declaring both to those of Damascus first, and also at Jerusalem and then throughout all the region of Judea, and even to the Gentiles, that they should **repent and turn to God, performing deeds appropriate to repentance.**"

Matt. 4:17 "From that time Jesus began to preach and say, '**Repent, for the kingdom of God is at hand.**'"

Rom. 7: 15 - 24 "Wretched man that I am! Who will set me free from the body of this death?"

Acts 3: 19, 26 "Repent therefore and **return**, that your sins may be wiped away, in order that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord. God raised up His Servant, and sent Him to **bless you** by turning every one of you from your wicked ways."

Rev. 2: 4, 5 "**But I have this against you, that you have left your first love. Remember therefore from where you have fallen, and repent and do the deeds you did at first;**"

Rev. 3: 19 "**Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline; be zealous therefore, and repent.**"

Is. 30: 18 "Therefore the Lord longs to be gracious to you, and therefore He waits on high to have compassion on you. For the Lord is a God of justice; How blessed are all those who long for Him."

Luke 5: 31, 32 "**It is not those who are well who need a physician, but those who are sick. I have not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance.**"

II Cor. 7: 9, 10 "The sorrow that is according to the will of God produces a repentance without regret."
