

## LORDS SUPPER - CHRIST OUR PASSOVER

Luke 22: 1, 7 - 8, 13 - 20 "Now the Feast of Unleavened Bread, which is called the Passover, was approaching." "I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer."

Ex. 12: 40 "Now the time that the sons of Israel lived in Egypt was four hundred and thirty years."

Ex 1: 13, 14 "The Egyptians compelled the sons of Israel to labor rigorously; & they made their lives bitter."

Ex. 2: 23 "The sons of Israel sighed because of the bondage, and they cried out; and their cry for help because of their bondage rose up to God."

Ex. 3: 7, 8, 10 And the Lord said, "I have surely seen the affliction of My people who are in Egypt, and have given heed to their cry because of their taskmasters, for I am aware of their sufferings. So I have come down to deliver them." "Come now Moses, and I will send you to Pharaoh, so that you may bring My people, the sons of Israel, out of Egypt."

Ex. 5: 1 - 2 Moses and Aaron came and said to Pharaoh, "Thus says the Lord, the God of Israel, 'Let My people go'; But Pharaoh said, "Who is the Lord that I should obey His voice to let Israel go? *I do not know the Lord*, and besides, I will not let Israel go." Ex. 10: 27 Ex. 14: 3, 4

**Ex. 12: 1 - 8, 11-14, 24-32, 43, 48**

John 6: 51, 53 "I am the living bread that came down out of heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he shall live forever; and the bread also which shall give for the life of the world is My flesh."  
Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in yourselves."

I Cor. 11: 26 "For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes."

John 1: 29 The next day John saw Jesus coming to him, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world."

**Heb. 11: 23 - 29** "By faith Moses -- considered the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures of Egypt."

I Cor. 11: 28 "Let a man examine himself, & so let him eat of the bread & drink of the cup."

I Cor. 5: 7 - 8 "Clean out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, just as you are in fact unleavened. For Christ our Passover also has been sacrificed. Let us therefore celebrate the feast, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice & wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity & truth."

Amos 4: 12 "Prepare to meet your God"

I Cor. 11: 23-25 For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took break; and when He had given thanks, He broke it, & said, "This is My body, which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me."

25) In the same way He took the cup also, after supper, saying, "This cup is the **new covenant** in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me."
