

FATHER'S SUFFERING WHILE JESUS WAS ON THE CROSS

I Sam 12: 24 "Fear the Lord & serve Him in truth with all your heart; for consider what great things He has done for you."

John 3: 35 "The Father loves the Son, and has given all things into His hand."

Matt. 3: 16, 17 And after being baptized, Jesus went up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending as a dove, and coming upon Him, and behold, a voice out of the heavens, saying, "*This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well-pleased.*"

Luke 6: 12, 13 "And it was at this time that He went off to the mountain to pray, and He spent the whole night in prayer to God. And when day came, He called His disciples to Him; and chose twelve of them, whom He also named as apostles

Matt. 6: 9, 10 "**Our Father who art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy name, Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven**

Matt. 8: 19 - 20 "The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air have nests; but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay His head."

Matt. 17: 5 While Peter was still speaking, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them; and behold, a voice out of the cloud, saying, "*This is My beloved Son, with whom I am well-pleased; listen to Him!"*

John 12: 27 - 36 "Now My soul has become troubled; and what shall I say, 'Father, save Me from this hour? But for this purpose I came to this hour. "Father, glorify Thy name." There came therefore a voice out of heaven: "*I have both glorified it, and will glorify it again.*"

Mark 14:36 **Abba! Father! All things are possible for Thee; remove this cup from Me; yet not what I will, but what Thou wilt**

Luke 22: 44 "And being in agony He was praying very fervently; and His sweat became like drops of blood falling down upon the ground." Matt. 26: 53 - 54 "**Do you not think that I cannot appeal to My Father, and He will at once put at My disposal more than twelve legions of angels? How then shall the Scriptures be fulfilled, that it must happen this way?"**

Matt. 26: 66-68 "He is deserving of death. (Luke 22: 64 Blindfolded Him). They spat in His face & beat Him with their fists; & others slapped Him, and said, "Prophecy to us, You Christ; who is the one who hit You?" Matt. 27: 26-31 "They put a crown of thorns on His head, took reed and beat Him on the head."

John 3: 16 "**For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life.**"

Matt. 27: 42-44 "He trusts in God; let Him deliver Him now, if He takes pleasure in Him; for He said, 'I am the Son of God.'"

Luke 23: 34 "**Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing.**" Matt. 27: 45,46 "From the 6th hour darkness fell upon all the land until the 9th hour. About the 9th hour Jesus cried out, "**My God, My God, why have you forsaken me?"**

Ps. 22: 1 - 3, 7 - 19 "But Thou, O Lord, be not far off; O Thou my help, hasten to my assistance."

Luke 23: 46 "**Father into Thy hands I commit My Spirit.**" Having said this He breathed His last.

John 19: 30 "**It is finished**" "And He bowed His head, and gave up His Spirit."

Mark 15: 39 "When the centurion, who was standing right in front of Him, **saw the way He breathed His last**, he said, "Truly this man was the Son of God." Luke 23: 47 "He began praising God."

Matt. 28: 18 Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "**All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations.**"

II Cor 5:21 He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him
