Acts 17: 10, 11 “They received the word with great eagerness, examining the Scriptures **daily**, to see whether these things were so.”

Deut. 17: 17– 20 “He shall read it all the days of his life, that he may learn to fear the Lord his God.”

Matt 6:11 “**Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our Daily Bread.**

Mark 1:15 “**The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent & believe in the gospel.**”

Matt. 4: 1 - 11 “**Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every Word that proceeds out of the mouth of God.**”

James 4: 7 “Submit therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.” **I Cor. 10: 13**

Job. 23:12 “I have **treasured** the Words of His mouth more than my necessary **food**.”

Ps. 119: 103 “How sweet are Thy words to my taste, yes sweeter than honey to my mouth.”

Mark 12: 1 – 11 “**Have you not even read this Scripture: ‘The stone which the builders rejected, this became the chief corner stone; this came about from the Lord, and it is marvelous in our eyes’?**”

Eph. 5: 1 “Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children; & walk in love just as Christ also loved you.”

I Cor. 2: 10 – 16 “We have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things freely given to us by God.”

Ps. 119: 34 “**Give me understanding**, that I may observe Thy law, **and keep it with all my heart**.”

Ps. 119: 125 “I am Thy servant; give me understanding, that I may know Thy testimonies.”

Ps. 119: 169 “Let my cry come before Thee, O Lord; give me understanding according to Thy word.”

Ps. 111: 10 “A good understanding have all those **who do** His commandments.”

Ps. 119:130 “The unfolding of Thy Words gives light, it gives understanding to the **simple**.”

Prov. 2: 1 – 15 Receive My sayings, and treasure My commandments within you, make your ear attentive to wisdom, incline your heart to **understanding**; for if you cry for discernment, lift your voice for **understanding**; if you seek her as silver, and search for her as for hidden treasures; then you will discern the fear of the Lord, and discover the knowledge of God,.... Knowledge will be pleasant to your soul.”

Ps. 119: 27 “**Make me understand** the way of Thy precepts, so I will **meditate** on Thy wonders.”

Ps. 111:2 “Great are the works of the Lord, they are studied by all who **delight** in them.”

Ps. 1:2 “His **delight** is in the law of the Lord and in His law he **meditates** day & night.”

Ps. 119:97 “O how **I love Thy law**, it is my meditation all the day.”

Ps. 4: 4 “Meditate in your heart upon your bed, and be still.”

Jos. 1: 8 “This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall **meditate on it** day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have success.”

Ps. 37: 7 “**Rest** in the Lord and wait patiently for Him.”

Ezra 7: 9, 10 “The good hand of God was upon him. For Ezra had **set his heart** to **study** the law of the Lord, and to **practice it**, & to **teach** His statutes & ordinances in Israel.” **Neh. 8**

Deut. 30: 11-20 “This commandment which I command you today is not too difficult for you, nor is it out of reach, But the word is very near you, in your mouth and in your heart, that you may observe it.”

Deut. 29: 29 “The secret things belong to the Lord our God, but the things revealed belong to us and to our sons forever, that we may observe all the words of this law.”

Ps. 138: 1-2 “I will give Thee **thanks with all my heart**; I will sing praises to Thee before the gods. I will bow down toward Thy holy temple, and give thanks to Thy name for Thy lovingkindness and Thy truth; for **Thou hast magnified Thy word** according to all Thy name.”

Rom. 1: 16 “For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the **power of God for salvation** to **everyone who believes**, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.”
