I Cor. 11: 24 "This is My body, which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me."

Luke 5: 16 - 25 But Jesus, aware of their reasonings, answered and said to them, "Why are you reasoning in your hearts? For Which is easier to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Rise, and walk'?"

Rom. 3: 23 "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."

Is. 59: 2 "Your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God."

Rom. 6: 23 "For the wages of sin is death."

Heb. 10: 4 "For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins."

TIME OF PERSONAL PRAYER.

Hand out Bread:

I Cor. 11: 23-25 For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took break; 24) and when He had given thanks, **(PRAYER)**

He broke it, & said, **“This is My body, which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me.”**

Hand out Drink:

25) In the same way He took the cup also, after supper, **(PRAYER)**

saying, **“This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.”**
