

## **OUR FAITHFUL AND RIGHTEOUS LORD**

Rom. 9: 33 “He who believes in Him will not be disappointed.”

**Rom. 9: 30 – 33** “Israel, pursuing a law of righteousness, did not arrive at that law. “Why? Because they did not pursue it by faith, but as though it were by works.”

**Rom. 10: 1 – 8** “Do not say in your heart, ‘Who will ascend into heaven?’ (that is, to bring Christ down), or ‘Who will descend into the abyss?’ (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead).” But what does it say? “The Word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart” that is, the word of faith which we are preaching.”

**Deut. 30: 11 – 14** “This commandment which I command you today is not too difficult for you, nor is it out of your reach.”

Rom. 10: 9 – 11 “If you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved; for with the heart man believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation.” For the scripture says, “**Whoever** believes in Him will not be disappointed.”

**Deut. 30: 15 – 20** “See, I have set before you today life and prosperity, and death and adversity; in that I command you today to **love the Lord your God**, to walk in His ways and to keep His commandments.”

**Rom. 10: 12 – 15** “For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the **same Lord is Lord of all, abounding in riches** for all who call upon Him.”

**Ps. 118: 22 – 29** “This is the day which the Lord has made; let us rejoice & be glad in it.”

Ps. 89: 1 “To all generations I will make known **Thy faithfulness** with my mouth.”

Rom. 10: 11 For the scripture says, “Whoever believes in Him will not be disappointed.”

Ps. 89: 15 – 17 “How blessed are the people who know the joyful sound! O Lord they walk in the light of Thy countenance. In **Thy name** they rejoice all the day. And **by Thy righteousness** they are exalted. For **Thou art the glory of their strength.**”
