

DO NOT BE AFRAID - CHRIST HAS COME

Matt. 1: 18 - 25 "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife; for that which has been conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit."

Luke 1: 67-79 "To grant us that we, being delivered from the hand of our enemies, might serve Him without fear, in holiness and righteousness before Him all our days."

Ex. 14: 13 But Moses said to the people, "Do not fear! Stand by and see the salvation of the Lord which He will accomplish for you today."

Judges 6: 22-24, 11-13, 9-10 The Lord said to him, "Peace to you, do not fear; you shall not die."

Deut. 6: 13 "You shall fear only the Lord, your God; and you shall worship Him."

II Kings 17: 39 - 41 "So while the nations feared the Lord, they also served their idols."

Matt. 10: 28 "Do not fear those who kill the body, but are unable to kill the soul; but rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell." Prov. 8: 13 "The fear of the Lord is to hate evil."

Eph. 5: 20, 21 "Always give thanks for all things in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ to God, even the Father; and be subject to one another in the fear of Christ."

I John 4: 18 "There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves punishment, and the one who fears is not perfected in love."

Ps. 115: 12, 13 "The Lord has been mindful of us; He will bless those who fear the Lord, the small together with the great."

Luke 5: 8-10 "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord!" "Do not fear, from now on you will be catching men."

Ps. 23: 4 "Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I fear no evil; for Thou art with me."

Luke 21: 9 "And when you hear of wars and disturbances, do not be terrified."

Acts 14: 21-22 "Through many tribulations we must enter the kingdom of God."

Ps. 27: 1 - 5 "The Lord is my light & my salvation; Whom shall I fear? The Lord is the defense of my life; Whom shall I dread?"

Gen. 26: 24 "Do not fear, for I am with you." Ps. 118: 6 "The Lord is for me; I will not fear;

Jos. 1: 8, 9 "This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have success. Have I not commanded you? Be strong & courageous! Do not tremble or be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go"

Prov. 3: 13, 23-26 "Blessed is the man who finds wisdom, & the man who gains understanding. Then you will walk in your way securely, and your foot will not stumble. When you lie down, you will not be afraid; when you lie down, your sleep will be sweet. Do not be afraid of sudden fear, nor of the onslaught of the wicked when it comes; for the Lord will be your confidence, & will keep your foot from being caught." Phil. 1: 14 "Speak the word of God without fear."

Heb. 2: 14, 18 "Jesus through death rendered powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil; and might deliver those who through fear of death were subject to slavery all their lives. Since Jesus was tempted in that which He has suffered, He is able to come to the aid of those who are tempted."

Rom. 8: 15 "For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!"
