Eph. 4: 32 "Forgive each other, just as God in Christ has forgiven you."

James 4:17 "To one who knows the right thing to do, and does not do it, to him it is sin."

John 15: 12 - 14 "This is My commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this, that one lay down his life for his friends. You are My friends, if you do what I command you."

Eph. 4: 30 - 32 "Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ has forgiven you."

Luke 5: 16 - 25 But Jesus, aware of their reasonings, answered and said to them, "Why are you reasoning in your hearts? For which is easier to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Rise, & walk'?"

Luke 23: 34 "Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing."

Acts 7: 59, 60 (Stephen) "Lord don't hold this sin against them."

Matt. 6: 12 "Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us."

Matt. 10: 8 "Freely you received, freely give."

Matt. 18:35 "Forgive your brother from your heart."

Matt. 22: 39 "You shall love your neighbor as yourself"

Jer. 31: 34 "I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more."
