I Cor. 11: 24 **"This is My body, which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me."**

Rom. 6: 10, 11 "For the death that He died, He died to sin, once for all; but the life that He lives; He lives to God. Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus."

Eph. 4: 32 "Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you."

**Matt. 18: 21-35** Peter came & said to Him, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me & I forgive him? Up to 7 times?" Jesus said to him, **"I do not say to you, up to 7 times, but up to 70 x 7."**

Rom. 3: 23 "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."

Is. 59: 2 "Your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God."

Rom. 6: 23 "For the wages of sin is death."

Is. 53: 10 "The Lord was pleased to crush Him, putting Him to grief; If He would render Himself as a guilt offering."

Ps. 32: 5 "Thou didst forgive the guilt of my sin."

Heb. 7: 25 "Hence also, He is able to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them."

#### **TIME OF PERSONAL PRAYER.**

##### **Hand out Bread:**

I Cor. 11: 23-25 For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took break; 24) and when He had given thanks, **(PRAYER)**

He broke it, & said, **"This is My body, which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me."**

##### **Hand out Drink:**

25) In the same way He took the cup also, after supper, **(PRAYER)**

saying, **"This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me."**
