

## PRACTICING SIN

I Cor. 6: 9 - 11 "Do you not know that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals, nor thieves, nor the covetous, nor swindlers, shall inherit the kingdom of God. And **such were some of you**; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, and in the Spirit of our God."

Gal. 5: 19 - 21 "Now the deeds of the flesh are evident, which are: immorality, impurity, sensuality, idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, disputes, dissensions, factions, envying, drunkenness, carousing, & **things like these, of which I forewarn you** just as I have forewarned you that those who **practice** such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God."

**I John 3: 1 - 10** "No one who abides in Him sins"

Ecc. 7: 20 "Indeed, there is not a righteous man on earth who continually does good & who never sins."

James 2: 10 - 11 "For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles **in one point**, he has become guilty of all.

**I John 1: 8-10, 2: 1-2** "If we confess our sins, He is faithful & righteous to forgive us our sins & to cleanse us **from all unrighteousness.**"

Mark 1:15 "**Repent and believe in the gospel.**"

**John 8: 1 - 11** "He who is without sin among you, let him be the first to throw a stone at her." Log in eye

Gal. 6: 1 "Brethren, even if a man is caught in any trespass, you who are spiritual, **restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, each one looking to yourself, lest you too be tempted.**"

**Heb. 12: 1 - 2** Ps. 119:11 "Thy word have I hid in my heart, that I might not sin against Thee."

Ecc. 12: 13,14 "The conclusion, when all has been heard, is: fear God & keep His commandments, because this applies to every person. For God will bring every act to judgment, everything which is hidden, whether it is good or evil."

Matt. 7: 13 "**Enter by the narrow gate; for the gate is wide, and the way is broad that leads to destruction, and many are those who enter by it. For the gate is small, and few are those who find it.**" **Matt. 7: 21 - 27**

II Cor. 13: 5 "Test yourselves to see if you are in the faith; examine yourselves! Or do you not recognize this about yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you - unless indeed you fail the test?"

**Rom. 1: 32** "Although they know the ordinance of God, that those who practice such things are worthy of death, they not only do the same, but also give hearty approval to those who practice them."

**Heb. 10: 26** "For if we go on **sinning willfully** after receiving the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins." **Defiant, rebellious sin**

**I Tim. 5: 24** "The sins of some men are quite evident going before them to judgment; for others, their sins follow after."

**Is. 32: 6** "For a fool speaks nonsense, and his heart inclines toward wickedness, to practice ungodliness and to speak error against the Lord, to keep the hungry person unsatisfied and to withhold drink from the thirsty."

**Lev. 18: 2, 3** "Then the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to the sons of Israel and say to them, 'I am the Lord your God. 'You shall not do what is done in the land of Egypt where you lived, nor are you to do what is done in the land of Canaan where I am bringing you; you shall not walk in their statutes. You are to **perform My judgments** and keep My statutes, to **live in accord with them**; I am the Lord your God.'" 29) "For whoever does any of these abominations, those persons who do so shall be cut off from among their people. Thus you are to keep My charge, that you do not practice any of the abominable customs which have been practiced before you, so as not to **defile** yourselves with them; I am the Lord your God."

**Heb. 12: 1, 2** "Therefore, since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us also **lay aside** every encumbrance, and **the sin which so easily entangles us**, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God."
