Ps. 34: 18, 19 "The Lord is near to the brokenhearted, and saves those who are crushed in spirit. Many are the afflictions of the righteous; but the Lord delivers him out of them all."

Ps. 25: 16 - 18 "Turn to me and be gracious to me, for I am lonely and afflicted. The troubles of my heart are enlarged; bring me out of my distresses. Look upon my affliction and my trouble, & forgive all my sins."

John 11: 25, 26 "I am the resurrection, and the life; he who believes in Me shall live even if he dies, and everyone who lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?"

Ps. 36: 9 "For with Thee is the fountain of life; In Thy light we see light."

Mal. 3: 6 "For I, the Lord, do not change." Matt. 28: 20 "I am with you always."

John 10: 10 "The thief comes only to steal, and kill, and destroy; I came that they might have life, and might have it abundantly."

Matt. 6: 33 - 34 "Seek first His kingdom and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added to you."

Matt. 24: 12 "And because lawlessness is increased most people's love will grow cold."

II Cor. 5: 15 "He died for all, that they who live should no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and rose again on their behalf."

Rev. 4: 11 "Worthy art Thou, our Lord and our God, to receive glory and honor and power; for Thou didst create all things, and for Thy pleasure they were created."

Ps. 8: 3 - 6 "When I consider Thy heavens, the work of Thy fingers, the moon and the stars, which Thou hast ordained; what is man, that Thou dost take thought of him? and the son of man, that Thou dost care for him? Yet Thou hast made him a little lower than God, and dost crown him with glory and majesty! Thou dost make him to rule over the works of Thy hands; Thou hast put all things under his feet."

Ps. 145: 5 "On the glorious splendor of Thy majesty, and on Thy wonderful works, I will meditate."

Ps. 19: 7 - 9 "The law of the Lord is perfect, restoring the soul". The precepts of the Lord are right, **rejoicing the heart**; The commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes. The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever."

Ps. 85: 9 "Surely His salvation is near to those who fear Him, that **glory** may dwell in our land."

Ps. 145: 18, 19 "The Lord is near to all who call upon Him, to all who call upon Him in truth. He will fulfill the desire of those who fear Him; He will also hear their cry and will save them."

Prov. 19: 23 "The fear of the Lord leads to life, so that one may sleep satisfied, untouched by evil."

Ps. 4: 8 "In peace I will both lie down and sleep, for **Thou alone, O Lord**, dost make me to dwell in safety."

Prov. 16: 6 "By the fear of the Lord one keeps away from evil."

Ps. 27: 13, 14 "I would have despaired unless I had believed that I would see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living. Wait for the Lord; Be strong, and let your heart take courage; Yes, wait for the Lord."

Ps. 42: 5 "Why are you in despair, O my soul? And why have you become disturbed within me? Hope in God, for I shall again praise Him for the help of His presence."

Ps. 25: 15 "My eyes are continually toward the Lord."

Ps. 46: 10 "Cease striving and know that I am God."

Ps. 34: 11 - 14 "Come, you children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the Lord, who is the man who desires life, and loves length of days that he may see good? Keep your tongue from evil, and your lips from speaking deceit. Depart from evil, and do good; seek peace, and pursue it."
