

"Master & servants" "Unfinished Tower" "King Going to War"

Job 14: 1 - 4 "Man, who is born of woman, is short-lived and full of trouble. Like a flower he comes forth and withers. Who can make the clean out of the unclean? No one!"

Matt. 6: 34 "So do not worry about tomorrow; for tomorrow will care for itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own."

Matt. 6: 33 - 34 "Seek first His kingdom & His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you. So do not worry about tomorrow; for tomorrow will care for itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own."

Luke 17: 5 The apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith!"

Luke 17: 6 And the Lord said, "If you had faith like a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and be planted in the sea'; and it would obey you."

Luke 17: 7 - 8 "Which of you, having a servant plowing or tending sheep, will say to him when he has come in from the field, 'Come immediately & sit down to eat'? But will he not say to him, 'Prepare something for me to eat, & properly clothe yourself & serve me while I eat and drink; & afterward you may eat & drink'?"

Luke 17: 9 - 10 "He does not thank the servant because he did the things which were commanded, does he? So you too, when you do all the things which are commanded you, say, 'We are unworthy servants; we have done only that which we ought to have done.'"

Ecc. 5: 19 - 20 Rejoice in his labor; this is the gift of God. For he will not often consider the years of his life, because God keeps him occupied with the gladness of his heart.

Luke 14: 28 - 30 "For which one of you, when he wants to build a tower, does not first sit down & calculate the cost to see if he has enough to complete it? Otherwise, when he has laid a foundation and is not able to finish, all who observe it begin to ridicule him, saying, 'This man began to build and was not able to finish.'"

Luke 14: 31 - 32 "Or what king, when he sets out to meet another king in battle, will not first sit down and consider whether he is strong enough with ten thousand men to encounter the one coming against him with twenty thousand? Or else, while the other is still far away, he sends a delegation & asks for terms of peace."

Luke 14: 33 "So then, none of you can be My disciple who does not give up all his own possessions."

Luke 11: 16-17 Others, to test Him, were demanding of Him a sign from heaven. Jesus knew their thoughts & said to them, "Any kingdom divided against itself is laid waste; & a house divided against itself falls."

Luke 11: 23 "He who is not with Me is against Me; and he who does not gather with Me, scatters."

Rom. 10: 17 So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.

I Cor. 3: 11 For no man can lay a foundation other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.
