

Luke 10: 21 At that very time Jesus rejoiced greatly in the Holy Spirit.

Luke 9: 54 - 56 When His disciples James and John saw this, they said, "Lord, do You want us to command fire to come down from heaven and consume them?" But Jesus turned and rebuked them, and said, "**You do not know what kind of spirit you are of; for the Son of Man did not come to destroy men's lives, but to save them.**" And they went on to another village.

Luke 10: 1 - 3 Now after this the Lord appointed seventy others, and sent them in pairs ahead of Him to every city and place where He Himself was going to come. And Jesus was saying to them, "**The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest. Go; behold, I send you out as lambs in the midst of wolves.**"

Luke 10: 17 - 21 The seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name." And Jesus said to them, "**I was watching satan fall from heaven like lightning. Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing will injure you. Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are recorded in heaven.**" At that very time He rejoiced greatly in the Holy Spirit, and said, "**I praise You, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from the wise and intelligent and have revealed them to infants. Yes, Father, for this way was well-pleasing in Your sight.**"

Luke 12: 48 "**From everyone who has been given much, much will be required.**"

Acts 3: 5 - 6 And he began to give them his attention, expecting to receive something from them. But Peter said, "I do not possess silver and gold, but what I do have I give to you: In the name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene--walk!"

Acts 3: 19 - 20 Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that He may send Jesus Christ, who was preached to you before.

Ps. 51: 12 - 13 Restore to me the joy of Your salvation and sustain me with a willing spirit. Then I will teach transgressors Your ways, and sinners will be converted to You.

Acts 3: 26 God, having raised up His Servant Jesus, sent Him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from your iniquities.

Luke 15: 7 "**I tell you that in the same way, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance.**"

Col. 1: 13 - 14 For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

Col. 1: 28 - 29 We proclaim Him, admonishing every man and teaching every man with all wisdom, so that we may present every man complete in Christ. For this purpose also I labor, striving according to His power, which mightily works within me.
