

Prov. 9:9 Give instruction to a wise man & he will be still wiser, teach a righteous man & he will increase his learning.

Prov. 9:10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, & the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding

Proverbs 1:7 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instruction.

Proverbs 10:3 The LORD will not allow the righteous to hunger, but He will reject the craving of the wicked.

Mat 10:14 "**Whoever does not receive you, nor heed your words, as you go out of that house or that city, shake the dust off your feet.**" Matt 5:6 "**Blessed are those who hunger & thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled**

1 Peter 3:8-10 Be compassionate and humble, not paying back evil for evil or insult for insult but, on the contrary, giving a blessing, since you were called for this, so that you can inherit a blessing. For the one who wants to love life and to see good days must keep his tongue from evil.

Romans 12:16-18 Do not be wise in your own estimation. Never pay back evil for evil to anyone. If possible, so far as it depends on you, be at peace with all men.

Proverbs 10:8-14 The wise of heart will receive commands. The mouth of the righteous is a fountain of life. Hatred stirs up strife, but love covers all transgressions. On the lips of the discerning, wisdom is found. Wise men store up knowledge., but with the mouth of the foolish ruin is at hand.

Proverbs 10:17-19 The one who follows instruction is on the path to life, but the one who rejects correction goes astray. The one who conceals hatred has lying lips, and whoever spreads slander is a fool. When there are many words, sin is unavoidable, but the one who controls his lips is wise.

Proverbs 10:20-23 The tongue of the righteous is choice silver; the heart of the wicked is worth little. The lips of the righteous feed many, but fools die for lack of wisdom. The blessing of the LORD makes one rich, and He adds no sorrow with it. To do evil is like sport to a fool, but a man of understanding has wisdom.

Proverbs 10:24-25 What the wicked fears will come upon him, but the desire of the righteous will be granted. When the whirlwind passes, the wicked is no more, but the righteous has an everlasting foundation.

Proverbs 10:28-29 The hope of the righteous shall be gladness: but the expectation of the wicked shall perish. The way of the LORD is strength to the upright: but destruction shall be to the workers of iniquity.

Proverbs 10:31-32 The mouth of the righteous brings forth wisdom. The lips of the righteous know what is acceptable, but the mouth of the wicked what is perverse.

James 3:9-10 With the tongue we bless our Lord and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in the likeness of God; from the same mouth come both blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not to be this way. James 3:13-15 Who among you is wise and understanding? Let him show by his good behavior his deeds in the gentleness of wisdom. But if you have bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in your heart, do not be arrogant and so lie against the truth. This wisdom is not that which comes down from above, but is earthly, natural, demonic. James 4:1 What is the source of quarrels and conflicts among you? Is not the source your pleasures that wage war in your members? James 4:3 You ask and do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, so that you may spend it on your pleasures.

Colossians 4:5-6 Conduct yourselves with wisdom toward outsiders, making the most of the opportunity. Let your speech always be with grace. Ecc. 10:12 Words from the mouth of a wise man are gracious.
